To whom it may concern,

Regarding partial noncompliance of Toyobo's resin PLANAC_{TM} with its performance data

registered with a third-party verification organization

PLANAC_{TM}, polybutylene terephthalate (PBT) resin manufactured and sold by Toyobo Co., Ltd., showed partial noncompliance with its performance data registered with Underwriters Laboratories

(UL), a third-party U.S. organization engaged in the analysis of safety data and promotion of

scientific knowledge. The noncompliance was a result of the submission of samples with a chemical

composition different from the product actually being sold when UL conducted a verification test on

an irregular basis.

UL conducted an investigation based on Toyobo's report and confirmed the noncompliant data. UL's

certification of the product in question will be rescinded in a sequential order from today.

We deeply apologize for the trouble and anxiety we caused to our clients and other stakeholders.

We have not received any reports of problems with the final products using PLANAC_{TM}, but we will

continue our investigation into the safety and performance of our product with cooperation from our

customers. Moreover, we have launched a third-party investigation into the circumstances and

causes of this incident.

We are taking the situation very seriously and urgently reviewing and strengthening the quality

control system so that we can prevent the recurrence of such an incident and do our best to restore

the credibility with our clients.

It is unclear how the latest incident will affect our business performance at this point. We will

disclose any serious effect in a timely manner whenever such announcement is deemed necessary.

This resin is used for electronic parts, including switches and connectors. Toyobo has been manufacturing

and selling the product since 2010 when it acquired the business, including the brand name, from another

company.
